Coffs Coast Archery Club is based in Woolgoolga on the beautiful North Coast of NSW. Coffs Coast Archery Club grounds are located 2.5km from Woolgoolga Town Centre and are set on 36 acres of plantation and rainforest grounds, leased from NSW Forestry Corporation.

Coffs Coast Archery Club has been established for over 21 years. Currently our youngest archer is 3 and our oldest is 75 years young.

Received news on 16/4/18 of a successful application of a grant under Local Sports Grant Program from NSW Office of Sport for \$1400 to buy new equipment for Juniors.

Results for IFAA International Indoor Mail Match were released on 18/4/18. Club had 9 members who competed, whom all finished in top 10 of their divisions. Club had 3 division winners, Harper Dent (Female Under 13 Recurve), Penny O'Doherty (Female Adult Recurve) and Tim Allen (Male Adult Open).

Last month in consultation with Mid North Coast Brain Injury Rehabilitation Service, we supported a member in efforts to receive funding for his archery for the whole year to support his continued rehabilitation and socialisation.

Coffs Coast Archery Club is the perfect place to get into a family sport that is disciplined and fantastic fun for everyone. We shoot from January right through to December every year, shooting outdoor 3D rubber animals, IFAA and FITA Field. We also shoot indoor target archery weekly, on a Thursday, at Coffs Harbour Showgrounds.

Many of our archers compete on regular basis in various locations around the state as well as interstate shoots and of these archers we have both National and State Champions.
